Collection of personal data

When you use our website, we process the personal data that your browser transmits to our server. The data transfer happens automatically as soon as you call up the website in your browser. The following personal data are processed and stored in log files on our server:

- IP address

- Time zone difference to coordinated universal time ("UTC" for short)
- Content of the request (specific page) with files sent
- Access status / HTTP status code
- Each transferred amount of data

- Browser
- Language and version of the browser
- Operating system and its interface

Purpose of processing

Operation of a website for:

- Securing the server or system operation

Legal basis for processing

The legal basis for processing is our legitimate interest in accordance with Article 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. f GDPR.

Period of storage of personal data

The period of the storage of personal data in log files is three months. They are then automatically deleted.

Collection of personal data

If you use the LiquidFeedback internal Perycles consortium instance by logging in with the access data provided to you, you must visit our website. The personal data mentioned under a) will be processed (see above). In addition, personal data of the following data categories are processed and stored:

- Master data
- Identification data
- Profile data
- Content data
- Usage data
- Login data and settings
- Session cookies

Purpose of processing

Use of the "LiquidFeedback" software for the internal use of the Perycles consortium.

Legal basis for processing

The legal basis for processing is our legitimate interest in accordance with Article 6 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 lit. f GDPR.

Period of storage of personal data

The personal data in the internal Perycles consortium instance of LiquidFeedback are stored from the date of first use by the authorized users of the respective organization until three months past the end date of the Perycles project, which is 31.12.2027. They will then be

completely deleted.

Categories of recipients

Categories of recipients to whom the personal data has been disclosed or are still being disclosed:

- Hosting-Provider
- Internal recipients
- Authorized users of the respective organization with the exception of login data and settings, session cookies and the data according to a) (see above).

Further processing for another purpose

There is no further processing of the data subject's data for purposes other than those mentioned in this data protection statement. If the controller intends to further process the data for another purpose, he will inform the data subject or, if necessary, obtain consent for this processing.

Transmission to recipients in third countries or international organizations A data transfer to bodies in countries outside the European Union (so-called third countries) or to an international organization will not take place and is not intended.

Automated decision-making

Automated decision-making in accordance with Art. 22 GDPR does not take place.

Rights of the data subject

Every data subject has

- the right of access by the data subject (Art. 15 GDPR),
- the right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR),
- the right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR),
- the right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR),
- the right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR) as well as
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR).

In addition, every data subject has the right to object to processing of personal data (Art. 21 GDPR), although the possibility of objection does not exist for data processing when visiting our website (point a), as the collection of personal data is absolutely necessary for the operation of the website.

To exercise the right to information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing, objection and data portability, an email to the controller is sufficient.
